They all lived together and were happy, as there was a lot of respect between them.


The roosters took care of the chickens and the big duck took care of the female ducks.

Mister João, owner of the farm, left his house in a hurry and began to collect all the female ducks and put them in the truck's cages.






Mister João did not consider the situation of solitude that would be that duck without his female ducks in the chicken coop.
